

## **School Plan for 2004-2005**

### 1. Enhancement of student proficiency in English, Chinese and Mathematics

Additional teachers will be employed to relieve the workload of the teachers. In turn, those teachers will then have the enhanced capacity to design and teach remedial / enhancement programmes and provide tutorial lessons in English, Chinese and Mathematics. Their additional duties will be to design and conduct extra-curricular activities to create a language-rich environment and to expose students to competitions in essay writing, verse speaking, etc. outside of school.

### 2. School self evaluation

The following tasks will be conducted in the coming year:

- i) follow up on the four tasks related to the two areas of concern: 'student learning' and 'school culture';
- ii) evaluate internal school appraisal system;
- iii) explore new items of self evaluation items and
- iv) prepare for External School Review.

### 3. Implementation of the S4-5 and S6-7 curricula

The new S4-5 and S6-7 curricula are being implemented and their effectiveness will be evaluated.
